Richland Township, Saginaw County Media Release - Regarding COVID-19

Richland Township offices will remain temporarily closed to walk-in traffic until May 31, 2020 following executive order 2020-59 (COVID-19). At this time, we are planning on opening the office to foot traffic on June 1st pending no changes by the Governor. Anyone needing Township services or who have a previously scheduled appointment should call the respective office before traveling to the Township administrative building. This decision is under the guidance of the Michigan Department of Public Health & Human Services, Governor Whitmer's Emergency Declaration and local public safety officials.
