Boxboard & Cardboard

Cereal boxes
Dry food boxes
Shoe and gift boxes
Paper towel rolls
Toilet paper rolls
Waxed milk and juice cartons
Brown paper bags
Corrugated cardboard

Mixed Containers

Individual beverage bottles
2 liter soda bottles
Milk jugs
Laundry detergent bottles
Clear, brown and green glass
Beverage glasses
Plates
Ceramic and cookware plate glass
Food cans
Foil food trays/pie plates
Empty aerosol cans
Food can lids and ends
Empty paint cans

All cardboard must be flattened and cut into 3' x 2'.

Separate paper from glass, cans, and plastics.
